#### Financials:

## Chairman's Report:

• Chairman Gilfeather asked each attendee to give an update as to how their business/industry is doing at the end of the call. This will be a new addition to board meetings.

### **President's Report:**

- Connecting with major investors early this year to retain them.
- Criteria changed for PPP loans and 501-c6 is now included as those who are eligible. Working with Orange Bank & Trust to secure PPP loan this year.
- The 2020 Annual Event was held on Zoom. Alan Guarino was the keynote and over 200 guests logged on. The fundraising goal for the event was exceeded by \$2,000.
- Pat DiCerbo of Northwestern Mutual assisted in securing new investors in 2020. He is going to continue assisting as Membership Chair in 2021.
- GFI Groundbreaking was held on November 24<sup>th</sup>. A desirable Food and Beverage manufacturer is having discussions with the owner regarding taking over the space.
- Delaware Engineering has drafted a corridor study to identify potential sites along Route 17K. Mary Beth Bianconi gave a brief update on that project.
- Mike Fleischer (Strategic Public Affairs) is advocating for the 17Forward86 coalition to secure infrastructure funds. Meetings between the board of the coalition and Mike continue.
- The Partnership provided support letters for both Central Hudson and Orange & Rockland regarding fines levied during Tropical Storm Isaias. Bob Sanchez and Anthony Campagiorni discussed this is more detail.
- There is a list of tentative events for 2021 in each folder. The Partnership will host a Golf Classic on Monday, May 17<sup>th</sup> at Otterkill Country Club.
- A sponsorship packet has been created including sponsor opportunities for all 2021 events. It will be distributed later this week to secure sponsors early.
- Working with Scannell and Town of Wawayanda regarding costly application fees. Drafted a letter seeking fee schedule with graduated payments.
- Changes taking place at the Orange County Chamber of Commerce. A discussion followed regarding the potential future of the organization.
